namaste, sawubona, kia ora, greetings to everyone,*

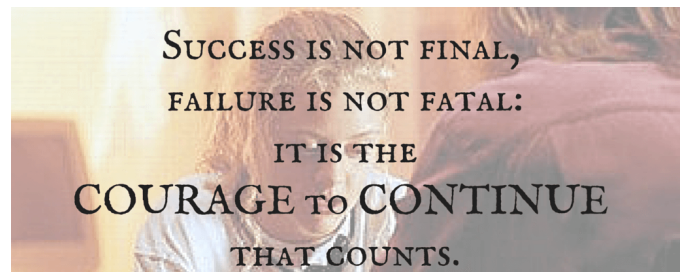
*What a lovely week we have all had at school.
