Class of the fortnight Room 24 Emma-Lee Dromgool



For our Science Inquiry this term, Room 24 students have been working with Rosie from Whitebait Connection to analyse the water quality of one of the local waterways, the Wairoa Stream. This involved a field trip to the stream, where we tested the water temperature, clarity, and acidity. We also used nets to gather and count bugs in the water. We have learned that the types of bugs and the amount found can indicate whether the stream is healthy or not. We then sketched the bugs we found using sketching techniques we have learned this term in Art.
