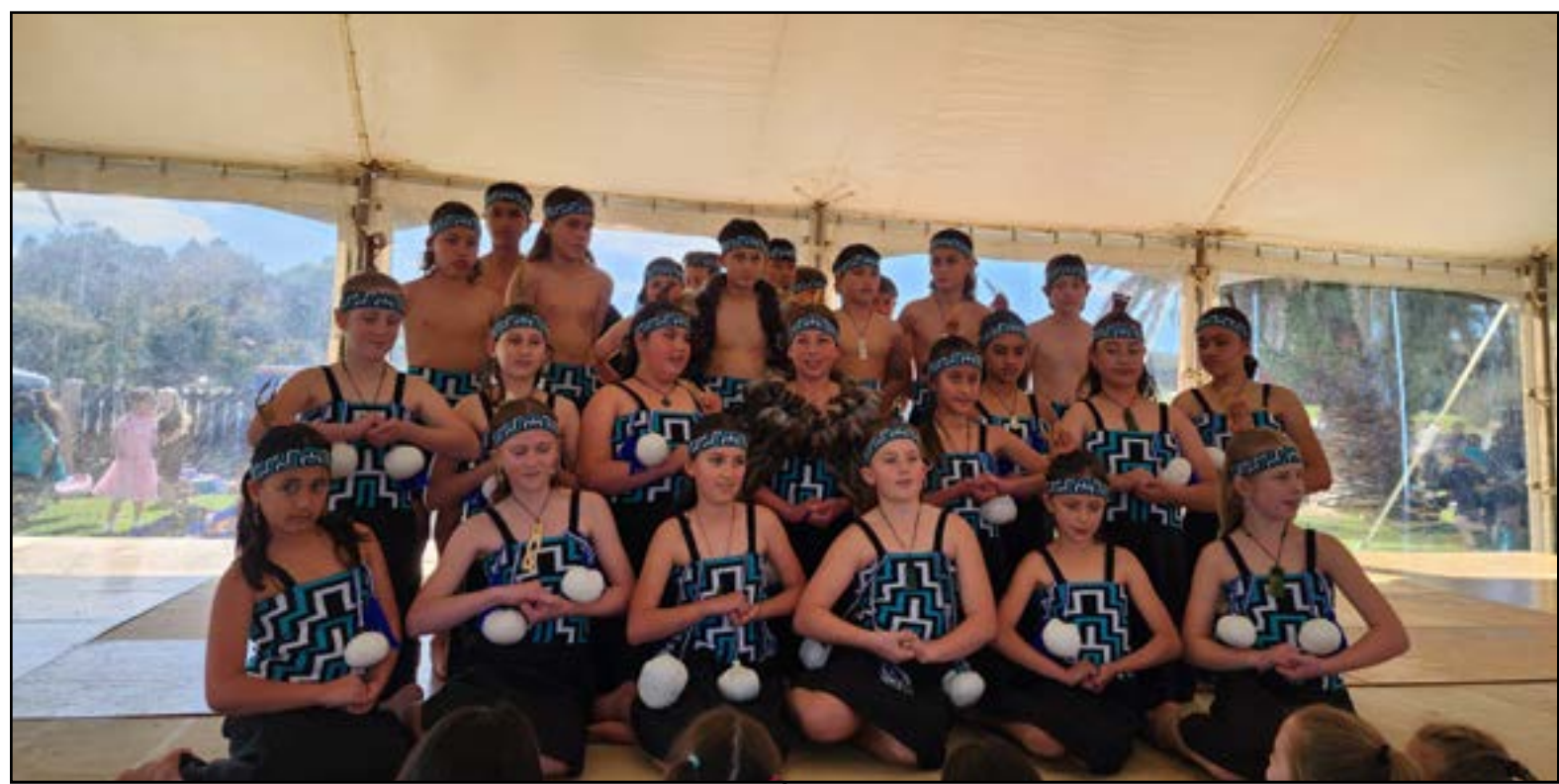


Kapa Haka Festival at Whitiara Marae
